

Study Abroad Application Steps

What Do I Need to Prepare for the Study Abroad Application?

Step 1:

- Basic personal information
- A copy of your passport (identity page)
 - If you don't have a passport yet, upload a Word document stating the date you applied and the expected arrival date
- A copy of your unofficial transcript
 - Available through Self-Service
- A minimum 300-word essay explaining why you want to study abroad
- Apply here.

Step 2:

- List the courses you plan to take abroad see page below for instructions.
- Apply <u>here.</u>



Step 2

1. Find Course Options

• Visit your program's website to view the most up-to-date course list for your term. Find all the courses that you might be interested in taking.

2. Check Previously Approved Courses

- Review the previously approved course list <u>here.</u>
- If your courses are already pre-approved, great—skip to Step 4.
- If a course appears more than once, choose the option that best fits your major.
- Note: This is a historical list showing how courses have transferred back to Lasell over the past 15 years. It is not a list of currently available courses. Always confirm the course is listed on your program's website for the semester you plan to study abroad.

3. Request Approval for New Courses (if needed)

- If a course is not on the approved list—or you want it to transfer back differently—submit a course approval request for each course by clicking here.
- Requests take 3–5 business days to process.
- Deadlines: Feb. 23 for Fall/Summer programs and Sept. 19 for Spring programs.
- Wait until your courses appear on the approved list before completing the rest of your application.

4. Choose Your Courses

- Select 4–5 primary courses you'd like to take abroad.
- Choose 3–4 backup courses in case your first choices aren't available.
- Minimum Recommendation:
 - 12 credits abroad = 4 primary + 2 backups
 - 15 credits abroad = 5 primary + 3 backups

5. Stay Organized

- Use the worksheet on the last page to track your course choices, or
- Write them in a document and save it for your reference.
